WHAT IS EDRLAB?

Non-profit association, ~54 members (<u>list</u>) worldwide

Works on standards, open-source software (via Readium) and accessibility

Revenue stream = membership fees and grants

Develops and manages the LCP DRM, worldwide

WHATIS READIUM?

Readium is NOT a reading app (i.e. a user agent)

Readium "2" is a set of toolkits (SDK), one per platform







W3C format: currently, waiting for producers.







